It was 2010 when women in emerging economies first told me that they didn't have access to relevant career advice. I had just spoken at the inaugural Qatar International Business Women's Forum conference attended by over 450 women from across the Middle East. Three women came up to me to bemoan the fact that all career advice books were written for Western women and that to get relevant help with their careers or businesses they had to spend precious money and time to physically attend an



event or meet with a mentor. Since then, women around the world repeatedly told me that they face the same problems.

Based on nearly thirty years of experience as a senior corporate leader, a small business owner, and a highly successful executive business coach, and after growing up in the Middle East and working and traveling in emerging economies, I know firsthand that there is a

gap between what a female university student knows and the skills she needs for professional success.

I set out to bridge these two gaps by writing the first career advice book for women in developing and emerging economies. I also built **The Way Women Work**, an online career advice platform which is visited daily by hundreds of women around the world.

I focus on successes. I know unequivocally that the global economy will only thrive when women are fully and equally engaged in driving prosperity. So, I equip women in emerging economies for professional and business success. This is my passion and life's work.




ABOUT THE BOOK
